### **BREATH OF FRESH AIR FOR CHESHIRE HOSPITALS**

South Cheshire-based Dame Hygiene Services Limited has come out on top by winning a contract to look after air quality at Mid Cheshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. The service from Dame Hygiene includes air freshening as well as the generation of ozone to inhibit the growth of airborne bacteria.

Sales manager Maureen Harrop explained: We have installed over 100 air freshening systems within Leighton Hospital, Crewe and the Victoria Infirmary, Northwich. But unlike conventional gas propelled technologies that can contribute to respiratory problems, we have installed gel-based dispensers that have been specifically developed to avoid the problem.”

As experts in their field Dame Hygiene are also supplying and servicing two ozone generators. “The generators are used to charge the air with positive ions which inhibit the growth of airborne bacteria. And because the generators are portable they can be moved to the area where the need is greatest,” explained Maureen who founded Dame Hygiene eleven years ago.

Sheila McDonald, assistant facilities manager for Mid Cheshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust said: “We are very pleased to be using a local supplier. With their team of service technicians they are able to provide a bespoke service and react more quickly to our needs than some of the much larger national competitors.”
